




SAUNDERSFOOT

WORLD ROWING COASTAL CHAMPIONSHIPS





EVENT DATES

The World Rowing Coastal Championships (WRCC) will take place from 7th to 9th October 2022.

EVENT CATEGORIES

There will be seven event categories in the 2022 World Rowing Coastal Championships:

- CM1x and CW1x (Solos)
- CM2x, CW2x, CMix2x (Doubles)
- CM4x+ and CW4x+ (Coxed Quads)

ENTRIES ARE NOW OPEN

Crews should enter and pay for their entry directly and then each Member Federation will receive a list of the entered club crews. Member Federations will confirm the entries and rank the crews accordingly and this will be communicated to World Rowing. The rank of each crew will be published after entries close.

The 2022 WRCC progression system will be published by World Rowing after the entry deadline as per World Rowing Rules of Racing.

The entry deadline is 9th September 2022.





ENTRY FEE

There is an entry fee of €35 per rowing seat. The fee will be used for a contribution towards the operational costs of the race organisation (for example, for safety cover, timing and results service, medals, volunteer insurance, boat stickers and racecourse infrastructure). €5 from each seat fee will be donated to support coastal rowing development programmes worldwide.

ACCREDITATION & CREW REGISTRATION

Crew members and team officials will receive their accreditation at the registration desk in the Regency Hall, Saundersfoot. Crew Captains will be required to bring photo identification (passport or international identification card) of all crew members to collect the accreditation for their crews. All competitors are required to carry their accreditation with them throughout the event. Crew Captains will be required to check and confirm their entries (and make any crew changes) with World Rowing at the registration desk in the accreditation centre.


VENUE AND COURSE OPENING TIMES

The venue will be open for accreditation and registration from 09:00 on Wednesday 5th October 2022. The course will be officially open for training from 09:00 on Wednesday 5th October 2022.



RACE COURSE

The rowing course will be in and around Saundersfoot Bay around turning points, with a mass beach start and water finish. The start beach is a fine sand beach with a sheltered spilling wave. Crews should have two experienced boat handlers at the start of the race and at shore for boat retrieval after the race. The course length will be 4 km for Heats and B Finals and 6 km for A Finals. Racing will be run in accordance with the World Rowing Rules of Racing and Appendix R18 – Coastal Rowing Competition Regulations.





UNIFORM

According to the World Rowing Rules of Racing, each crew member must display on their racing suit the three-letter country code and their family name (in Romanised text), following the format below:

The boat handlers shall wear matched uniforms in a colour that is different from the crew. World Rowing may also issue the boat handlers with bibs to wear (see World Rowing Rules of Racing Appendix R18 – Coastal Rowing Competition Regulations).

OFFICIAL BOAT HIRE PROCEDURE

Swift, Filippi, Ave, Kanghua and Nelo are the official boat hire providers for this event (World Rowing Coastal Championships only). For boat rentals, please contact your chosen manufacturer directly. Boats will be rented on a first come first served basis. If your preferred manufacturer no longer has any boats for your race you will need to contact your second option of boat manufacturer.

If you make a private hire arrangement with a non-official supplier your boat will be treated as a private boat and the supplier will not be able to have a support presence in the boat park in Saundersfoot Harbour or on the beach unless they wish to hire an exhibition space, if so, please contact communications@worldrowingcoastals2022.org. You will need to buy a ticket to book into an allocated boat park in Coppet Hall (10 minutes walk from Saundersfoot Harbour) for £12 for the weekend.

All boats and other equipment shall comply with World Rowing Rules of Racing, including specified safety equipment. All official hire boats & oars will be shared between teams, and the Official Suppliers cannot guarantee that crews will have the same equipment each day within their rental fleet.

Rowers are reminded that they are expected to have a floating bow line on their boat and a lifejacket for each rower on their craft for all training and racing. Coxes must wear a lifejacket. Buoyancy aids are an aid to buoyancy and not considered a lifejacket. If you are flying with a lifejacket that has a CO2 canister, it is advisable to contact your airline beforehand. Some airlines request that you have the CO2 canister in the hold, some in the cabin and some do not allow you to fly with them.






BRINGING YOUR OWN BOATS

We are very happy for you to bring your own boats, please notify the OC by email (worldrowingcoastals2022@britishrowing.org) before the closing date of entries to ensure that there is space in the boat park for you in Coppet Hall, and:

If you miss the deadline to notify the OC regarding boats and equipment, a £100 beach boat parking fee will be charged and billed to you after the event.

BOAT WEIGHING

On arrival, all boats can be weighed outside the Saundersfoot Sailing Club and registered by World Rowing and the Organising Committee. The boats will then be given their boat number sticker (stickers will be put on the boat by the OC, not given to crews). During the competition days, verification procedures will take place (to verify the weight information, measurements, equipment, advertising and any other requirements) and there will be random boat weight screenings.

DAR RENTAL

Croker, Concept2 and Braca are official oar manufacturers for this event.

For oar rentals, please contact the suppliers below directly. The oar manufacturers will also hire on a first come first served basis.

TIMING

Timing will be managed by Lap2Go and will include live tracking on boats which will be shown on the big screen at the event.

All trackers need to be returned after racing. There will be a charge of £25 for every lost tracker that will be billed for after the event.

RESPONSIBILITY OF CREW CAPTAINS

Teams are reminded that coastal rowing is an assumed risk sport and the Crew Captain shall be responsible for assessing the risks and the ability of the crew to cope with the prevailing and forecast conditions (see World Rowing Rules of Racing Appendix R18 19.c.ii). Crews that feel they are not competent or confident to train or race in the conditions, are expected not to go on the water and to inform the organising committee at the earliest opportunity of their decision.

There will be a crew captains briefing on Thursday 6th October at 18:00 in the Regency Hall, Saundersfoot. Only crew captains are to attend and a register will be taken.





NORLD ROWING BEACH SPRINT



EVENT DATES

The World Rowing Beach Sprint Finals 2022 (WRBSF) will take place from 14th to 16th October 2022.

EVENT CATEGORIES

There will be nine event categories in the 2022 World Rowing Beach Sprint Finals:

- Senior events:
- CM1x and CW1x (Solos)
 - CMix2x (Doubles)
- CMix4x+ (Coxed Quads)
 - Under 19 events:
- CJM1x and CJW1x (Solos)
- CJM2x, CJW2x and CJMix2x (Doubles)

Member Federations are reminded that the rules for the coastal discipline require rowers to be responsible for making decisions in relation to their level of skills. Please make sure your teams have suitable experience of racing in waves alongside their rowing competency.

Teams are advised to bring two experienced boat handlers to support their crews during training and racing. Please note that teams should not bring boats since pool boats will be provided by Filippi. However, teams are advised to bring their own oars. World Rowing's Coastal Commission is happy to advise Member Federations who are looking for good training locations.

EVENT FORMAT - TIME TRIALS

Where the first round of racing is time trials, a "processional" time trial format will be used instead of the side-by-side format. This will allow the time trial rounds to be run over a shorter duration and be less affected by changes in the course due to the large tidal range.

In the processional time trial crews will start one after the other at approximately 1-minute intervals, racing on the same course. Each crew will slalom out in one lane, followed by two 90-degree anti-clockwise turns, and then race directly back to the beach in the second lane. Each crew will start and finish their time trial with the usual beach run. Further details will be provided closer to the entry deadline.

Due to the complex tidal movement teams are not encouraged to double up as the race schedule may change.

ACCREDITATION

Crew members and team officials will receive their accreditation at the registration desk in the Regency Hall. Team Managers will be required to bring photo identification (passport or international identification card) of all crew members to collect the accreditation for their crews. All competitors are required to carry their accreditation with them throughout the event.

RESPONSIBILITY OF TEAM MANAGERS

Teams are reminded that coastal rowing is an assumed risk sport and the Team Manager shall be responsible for assessing the risks and the ability of the crew to cope with the prevailing and forecast conditions (see World Rowing Rules of Racing Appendix R18, point

19 on coastal safety). Crews that feel they are not competent or confident to train or race in the conditions, are expected not to go on the water and to inform the organising committee at the earliest opportunity of their decision.

There will be a team managers' meeting on Thursday 13th October at 15:00 in the Regency Hall, Saundersfoot. There will also be a daily team manager meeting on each racing day, 60 minutes after the start of the last race.

VENUE AND COURSE OPENING TIMES

The venue will be open for accreditation and registration beginning on Wednesday 12th October from 09:00. The course will be officially open for training from 09:00 on Wednesday 12th October.





BEACH ORIENTATION

The Beach Orientation will include a walk through the wave break, familiarisation of the beach features and direction on how to call for assistance. Team managers should book their rowers and boat handlers onto a Beach Orientation slot at accreditation. The session will last 30 minutes. Participants should come in training kit, ready to get wet and have their accreditation ready to be stamped.

OFFICIAL TRAINING

Only teams that have attended a Beach Orientation session will be allowed to participate in official training. Teams will need to book onto official training slots on training days.

Teams shall also confirm their training slot at accreditation when they arrive in Saundersfoot.

BOATS AND EQUIPMENT

The Official Pool Boat Supplier for the WRBSF will be Filippi. The organising committee will provide these pool boats during training and competition.

The crews are required to bring their own oars and blade colours MUST be country colour/design.

The pool boats will have standard rigging which cannot be changed. Teams are advised to use the measurements on their private oars to allow for personal preferences in gearing and angles. Personal seat pads and footwear may be used. The pool boats will be set at 5 degree of pitch, 0.5- 1 degree of lateral and 158cm span, and set at the maximum height.

At the time of writing, competitors for both events will not be eligible for any elite sport exemptions from restrictions in the UK and there are currently (as of July 2022) no Covid restrictions in place in the UK that would affect travel, but please check

SUSTAINABILITY
