IMPORTANT NOTES FOR CLUBS AND COMPETITORS

Entries and Fees: Senior events £9 per rowing seat, coxes free. (IV = £36, VIII = £72)
Junior events £7 per rowing seat, coxes free. (IV = £28, VIII = £56)

Entries accepted only via BROE and close 22:00 Friday 31st May.

Payment via BROE or by cheque to be made payable to **DURHAM REGATTA**.

All payments must be received by close of entries.

Please ensure that BROE contact details are accurate in case of entries queries.

If paying by cheque please send summary forms and cheques either per crew or preferably per club to:-

Entry Limits: The Regatta Committee reserves the right to limit entries to particular events or the regatta as a whole. The regatta often reaches its entry limits so please ensure you enter early to avoid disappointment.

Double Entries: Competitors/Crews/Coxes/Equipment may only enter one event per division.

Masters Handicap Events: will be organised in accordance with the guidance provided in the 2013 Masters Handicap Events Operating Notes.

Minimum Numbers: A minimum of three entries from two different clubs are required for an event to be held. If insufficient entries are received, the entries will be placed in the next category/age group for the class of boat unless an alternative is clearly stated. The Entries Secretary will endeavour to contact Club Secretaries and Teachers i/c of Rowing to resolve any difficulties – please ensure that BROE contact/phone number records are correct.

Change of Status: Clubs should be aware that the draw takes place on Sunday 2nd June. Crews who change status on Saturday 1st June should inform the Entries Secretary before 20:00 on Saturday 1st June and will be entered in the next highest status event.

Inexperienced Crews: Durham Regatta is a very busy event and we ask that Club Captains and Coaches consider the experience of their crews prior to entering them. Typically we suggest that crews have competed in at least two regattas earlier in the season.

Novice & Intermediate 3 winners on Saturday: The Sunday draw will allow space for winners in open & women's 8+ and 4+ events from the first day of Durham Regatta, to accommodate any consequent change of status.

Rowability Competitors: where possible please notify us as early as possible of your intention to enter using the contact details above. This will help us to take any special needs/requirements into account in advance of close of entries.

Cancellation Policy: in the event of cancellation or suspension of the regatta the committee will endeavour to refund 50% of entry fees where crews have not raced after unavoidable costs have been covered.

DRAW: Will take place at 15 Glebeside, Witton Gilbert commencing 10:00 on Sunday 2nd June.

PRIZE GIVING: Will take place at Durham Town Hall on Sunday 9th June commencing 20:00.
