British Rowing Offshore Championships returns to Sandbanks Beach, Poole, this August.

You are invited to the British Rowing Offshore Championships, a celebration of coastal rowing.

- Saturday, 18 – Sunday, 19 August 2018

What

Racing will be held on Saturday, 18 August and Sunday, 19 August. Coastal singles (C1x), doubles (C2x) and quads (C4x), in the men's and women's events will race.

Racing starts with competitors jumping into their boats before rowing off the shore to the first turning buoy, before heading out along the remainder of the course. To finish, crews row back onto the shore, with one nominated member of the crew jumping out of the boat to run across the finish line on the beach. It's a dramatic start and finish that simply cannot be missed!

Who

Club rowers from across the UK, as well as international representation.

Why

To award National Champion titles to men's and women's crews across the three disciplines.

This year's event is also a qualifying round for those wishing to go to the 2017 World Coastal Rowing Championships in Thonon, France.
