Summary of crews by event:

The progression for the 2018 British Rowing Offshore Championships is as follows:

Women's Quad, Women's Double Scull and Women's Solo (CW4x+, CW2x, CW1x)

Format: There will be no heats, all crews will race in the final

Heats: No heats

Finals: Final A

CW4x+, CW2x, CW1x,	No heats	Final A

Open Quad (C4x+)

Format: Two heats and one final

Heats: The first 3 crews in each heat go forward to Final A, the remainder are eliminated

Finals: Final A will have six crews

C4x+	H1, H2	1-3 -> FA, 4...elim
------	--------	---------------------

Open Double Scull and Open Solo (C2x, C1x) - 7 to 16 crews

Format: Two heats and one final

Heats: The first 4 crews in each heat go forward to final A, the remainder are eliminated

Finals: Final A will have eight crews

C2x, C1x	H1, H2	1-4 -> FA, 5...elim
