# Great Britain Rowing - Beach Sprints Team

## Boat Handler/Coach Role & Responsibilities

- Responsible to the GBRBST Team Manager

### Prior to the event

- Arranges appropriate team training and crew development opportunities
- Writes the team training programme
- Develops the teams technical and tactical strategies including optimal boat entry and exit

### At the event

- Directs performance in training and racing and leads evaluation of performances
- Leads boat handling strategy and upskills rowers in their boat handling roles
- Takes responsibility for correct set up of boat and blades
- Leads coaching and strategy for GBRBST crews
- Oversees duty of care for rowers in the GBRBST
- Ensures team safety, discipline, morale and standards are of a high standard.
- Deputises for GBRBST Team Manager in relevant team meetings.

### After Event

- Writes a report for the Team Manager evaluating the crews formation, development and performances and summarising key lessons learnt.

## Requirements for All Team Management Positions

### Essential

- Able to communicate effectively with rowers and coaches.
- Confirmation that you have read, understood and agreed to abide by British Rowing's Code of Conduct and Anti-Doping Policies.
- Provide 2-character references.

### Desirable

- Current First Aid qualification.
- UKCC Level 2 Certificate in coaching rowing or equivalent.
