There have been a number of enquiries regarding the addition of new racing classes and events, based on the Invictus Games, within the Adaptive section of BRIC so we thought this information might be useful to explain everything.

Adaptive rowing classes available at BRIC 2019 and how they relate to the Invictus categories:

IR1 = IR1

AR1 = IR2

IR3 = IR3

AR2 = IR4

AR3-PD = IR5

ARs-LD = no IR equivalent

AR3-Open = IR6

ALL those who enter a Para/Adaptive/Invictus event will have to be officially classified for the event, either in advance on one of the British Rowing classification days, or on the morning of BRIC.

If being classified on the day, all relevant paperwork will need to be brought along to be shared with the classifiers, alongside taking part in a functional assessment to ensure the correct classification has been assigned.

To enter the AR3-Open category competitors will need to complete a self-declaration form which can be requested by emailing simon.goodey@britishrowing.org.

Those with a Para (PR) classification are able to enter the following events:

2,000m

4 minutes

1 minute

Those with an Adaptive (AR) classification are able to enter the following events:

2,000m

4 minutes

1 minute

Those with an Invictus (IR) classification are able to enter the following events:

4 minutes

1 minute
