Endurance

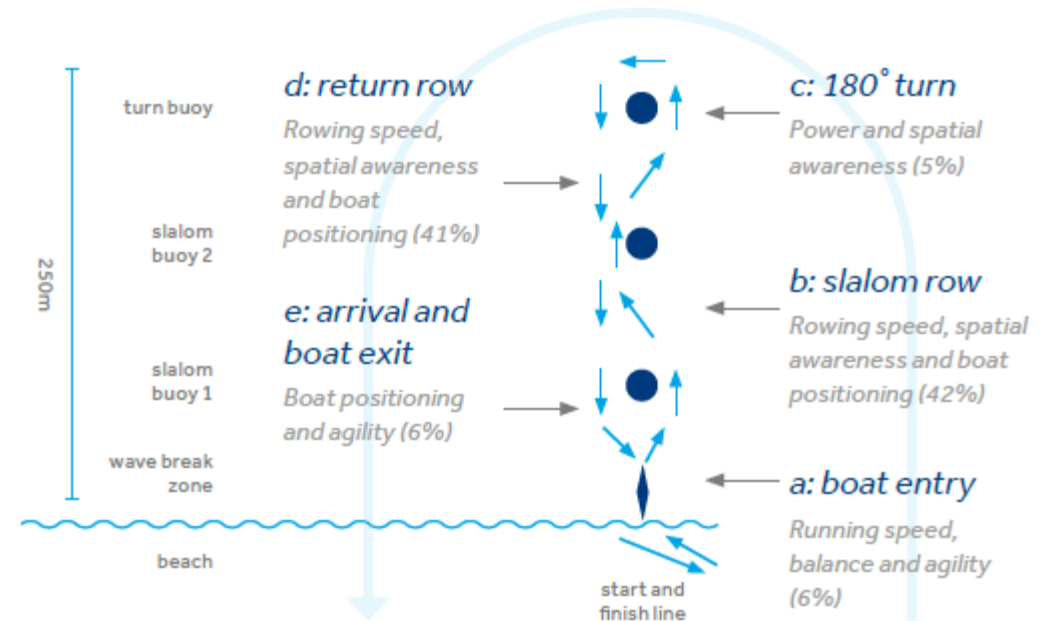
- 4-6k triangular course, mass start, takes place offshore
- Domestic events (primarily SW based), British Rowing Coastal Championships, World Coastal Championships (club crews)
- 1x, 2x, 4x – single sex and mixed events



The Basics – Coastal Rowing Formats

Beach Sprints

- 2 lane course, 2x250m+sprint
- 1x, Mix2x, Mix4x
- British Rowing Beach Sprints Championships, World and European Championships (international crews), World Beach Games
- Proposed for Inclusion in Olympics from 2028, plus Commonwealths from 2026

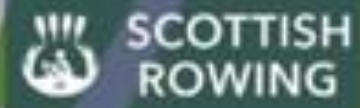
