





#### **WORLD COASTAL AND BEACH SPRINTS**


- All nine GB crews made it through to the top 8 with four slivers, a bronze and two 4<sup>th</sup> places.

- Qualifying all three of those boats for the World Beach Games in Bali next year (which required a top-six finish for qualification).









## **The Coaching Stream**

The coaching stream is British Rowing's coach development offer Coaches can choose from three learning preferences to help them develop their coaching practice.

- 1. Discover helps coaches to understand the wide range resources they can access anytime and anywhere, in a format that works for them
- 2. Connect means that coaches will be able to access more openly available and well publicised opportunities to work with others from grass roots to performance level
- 3. Guide signposts to learning through our formal qualifications, mentored programmes, workshops, and conferences

# **British Rowing Grow Update**

- Three GROW coaches were deployed at the beginning of September, working out of Broxbourne Rowing Club, Dorney Boat Club and Warrington Youth Rowing.
- The primary focus is to engage with young people from local state schools, with low socio-economic, ethnically diverse backgrounds, and those who have a disability.
- The GROW coaches will be working with young people to identify and help overcome potential barriers to staying in the sport.
- The programme is using a system called 'upshot' to measure the impact on young people getting involved in rowing and provide insight to help us understand how we can support more people feel they belong in the rowing community.



## Learning, Education and Development Coaching statistics



There are currently 2136 British Rowing members with a COACH membership or a coaching qualification.



In the last twelve months 347 coaches attended a formal coaching qualification.



194 coaches engaged in an activity during Coaching Week



156 club members and 78 students have signed up for the coaching assistant training since its launch in September






