

British Rowing Masters Championships 2023 Car & Trailer Parking

Car Parking

- Competitors and supporters should follow the directions of marshals on the day. You will be directed to park on the grassy bank, overlooking the regatta lake.
 Overflow parking will be available in (I) "Car Park B" and then (2) the Outdoor Activity Zone.
- Please note, Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) is in place on the car parks at the National Watersports Centre. The NWSC levies a charge of £5 per vehicle per day. Event parking can be purchased in advance via the NWSC website, or follow instructions on the signs around the parking area.
- The NWSC indicates that a fixed penalty notice will be issued in the post by a third party if no payment is allocated next to a registration number.

Trailer Parking

- Trailer drivers should follow the directions of marshals on the day. Trailer parking is available (1) on the grassy bank and (2) in the Rugby Club car park.
- The grassy bank is expected to fill up first and will be closed once at capacity.
- Trailers and towing vehicles must be parked with consideration to ensure the space can be maximised and no other vehicles are blocked in.
- Vehicles transporting boats (either towing trailers or on the roof) are subject to the same parking charges listed above.
- Access will be available from <u>10:00</u> on Friday 9 June. The gates will be locked at 20:30.
- Access will be available from **07:00** on Saturday 10 and Sunday 11 June.
