

## **Entering the ERCC**

## Introduction

The European Rowing Coastal Championships are an international coastal event split into club and national federation events. The European Rowing Club Coastal Championships are open only to European club crews nominated by the member federation in which they are located whilst the European Rowing Coastal Championships are open to European national team crews nominated by their member federation. British Rowing as the National Federation is responsible for the ranking of club crews representing Great Britain in the European Rowing Club Coastal Championships and the selection of rowers representing Great Britain in the European Rowing Coastal Championships.

The 2023 event will be held in La Seyne-Sur-Mer, France from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 3<sup>rd</sup> of September.

## Entering

All crews/clubs looking to be considered for inclusion in either the European Rowing Club Coastal Championships or the European Rowing Coastal Championships must be submitted to British Rowing no later than 09:00 7<sup>th</sup> August 2023. via the <u>British Rowing Boat</u> Entry Form.

Entries will be confirmed by **17:00** 7<sup>th</sup> **August 2023**. British Rowing will share the login details for entries and payments (45 EUR per seat) to be made on the online entry portal by successful crews/clubs following this time.

Entries to this portal close on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2023 and will be made by the selected clubs.

All nations (including Great Britain) entering the ERCC are limited to the number of boats that they are allowed to enter in endurance events at the European Rowing Coastal Championships. **Please do not book accommodation or transport until your entry place has been confirmed.**
