


Online Survey and Feedback Outcomes SUMMARY

- What distance should it be raced over? 2000m

2023 Survey Respondent Preferences




Respondents to 2023 survey by category in relation to the May/June or July options




May – June Standalone Regatta


Force Field Analysis

Important elements for a successful Championships



Core Principles for Senior Races (Based on Survey & Feedback)

AN INCLUSIVE EVENT

- Events for multiple-levels ("Elite", "Club", "Beginner")
- Appropriate boat types at each level
- At least one lightweight, mixed & adaptive event (subject to minimum entry)
- Flexible entry enter crew rather than athletes to reduce drop out
- Affordable entry fees

A HIGH QUALITY & REWARDING EXPERIENCE FOR ALL ATTENDEES

- Athletes Ideal minimum of 2 races per crew; Gold, Silver, Bronze medals
- Volunteers Engage & Activate both local and entry club volunteers
- Umpires Incentivise attendance with expense support and regatta facilities
- Spectators Live race information & commentary, online streaming, off water features

EXECUTIONAL EXCELLENCE

- Plan and progressively develop year on year
- Leverage professional staff to engage and activate membership community
