These opportunities in year one, will have three Cohorts and will not only promote learning, but help to shape the role of coaching in an everchanging society. The Cohorts are:


Cohort One: Developing and rewarding people who want to make a difference in coaching

I-I support from a Coach Developer, who will work with you to develop a Personal Development plan focusing on your **needs** and **wants**.








What does it not mean?
