#### **Race Committee**

- Chair on Organising Committee
- Appointed by Race Committee Chair
- Must all be umpires, minimum of 3
- Generally just on the day
- Takes decisions on conduct of racing not in province of an officiating umpire
- Hears protests
- Provide support & advice
- Suspension of racing, course alterations
- Liaise with Race Umpire
- Consulted on racing postponements
- Decide on situations not in Rules
- Apply disciplinary measures

# Co-ordinating Umpire

- Appointed by Race Committee Chair
- Where several race umpires are involved in a race e.g. Bank or zonal/static umpired
- On Race Committee
- Overhear all communications between umpires
- Should be told of all warnings during the race
- Signals outcome of race to Finish Judges
- Manages protests
- Must be umpire (or trainee under direct supervision)
- Note: Not Race Control or Programme Controller

- Chair
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- Entries Secretary
- Race Committee Chair
- Safety Adviser (CRSA)
- Welfare Officer

#### **Race Committee Chair**

- Appointed by OC in advance
- Advises OC on Rules of Racing

#### And:

- Appoints Race Committee
- Appoints umpires & additional officials
- Allocates duties
- Equipment
- Local Rules (approved by local RUC)
- Approves early starts & use of 2 minutes
- Decisions not in rules
- Substitutions (medical)
- Weighing-in procedures
- Moderates processional penalties
- Public Warnings
- Disciplinary measures
- Meets RUC/NUC Rep

# **Stopping/Suspending Racing**

- Race Committee Chair
- Safety Adviser
- Umpire (individual race)
- Consult if time

## **Delay**

- At discretion of Starter and Programme Controller
- Starter, Judge at the Start, Chief Judge (at Finish)
- Race Umpires, Head of Control Commission
- Additional Finish Judges and CC members
- Responsible for conduct of race
- Could be trainee under direct supervision
- Disciplinary measures (official warnings etc.)

#### Local RUC

- Approves Local Rules prior to publication
- Receives all published material

### **RUC (NUC for National Competitions)**

- Sends representative to monitor whether umpiring standards are being maintained And may also:
  - Help if necessary
  - Provide an experienced second opinion
  - Give advice on best practice
  - Produce report for RUC (or NUC) and OC

### **Safety Adviser**

- Develop Safety Plan, Risk Assessment, etc.
- Inspections, audits & feedback to OC
- Safety & Welfare Plan (to RRSA for approval)
- Report incidents via British Rowing website

#### **Welfare Officer**

- Advise on safeguarding & Handbook 3
- Welfare Plan
- Point of contact.

### **Organising Committee**

- Appoints Safety Adviser
- Appoints Welfare Officer
- Appoints Programme Controller
- Appoints Control Commission
- Produces Risk Assessment, Safety Plan & Welfare Plan with Race Committee Chair, Safety Adviser & Welfare Officer
