

Victor Ludorum Rules 2026

1. The Victor Ludorum prize and trophy will be awarded to the club which has accrued the most points at the British Rowing Masters Championships. There will be additional prizes for the large, medium and small clubs which have accrued the most points. The categorisation of clubs is published on the Masters Championships webpage.
2. In order to accrue points a club must win an A final ranking in the Championship events or a win in a Tier I Intermediate event.
3. The following points will be awarded for each final placing by each club in Open, Women's and Mixed Championship events:

4. The following points will be awarded for each win by each club in Tier I of all Intermediate events:

8+	16
4x/4+	12
2x	8
1x	4

5. There will be no VL points awarded for composite crews.
6. Clubs will only accrue points for their highest placed crew in any final.
7. A provisional result will be announced at the end of each day's racing.
8. If racing has to be cancelled the Victor Ludorum prize will only be awarded if, at the point of cancellation, the result is beyond doubt if the remaining finals had occurred (i.e. the leading clubs are so far ahead they can't be caught).
9. In the event of any dispute the decision of the Organising Committee is final.
