Incident Reporting (safety)

This reporting system is for everyone (Clubs, Individuals, Events, 3rd Parties) who needs to report an incident or concern, whether or not damage, injury or a health issue has occurred.

Please go to [British Rowing Incident Reporting](#) and report whatever you see, it does not matter how much, if any, harm was caused.

Reporting an Incident is your chance to make your contribution to improving rowing safety. We can all learn from reports and this enables us to make improvements that will keep rowers safe.



Safeguarding

If your concern relates to child or adult safeguarding at your club, please report the instance to us using our safeguarding [Report a Safeguarding Concern](#) form. Club Welfare Officers should continue to deal with the matter at your discretion, or where the matter concerns a child, or adult at risk, who is at immediate risk of harm, it should be reported to the emergency services.
