Entries Statement - 12 May 2026

The 2026 British Rowing Masters Championships has seen an unprecedented number of entries. On 3 May, entries were suspended for the Saturday, as it had reached capacity, and on the 5 May, entries were closed for the Sunday. A waiting list was put in operation for both days and the Organising Committee has, and continues to work to get as many crews as possible a race at this year's Championships.

In order to maximise the number of crews getting a race as possible, entries will be moved from the wait list in the order in which they were entered, and if they are complete (i.e. paid and without any placeholders), according to the following strategy:

1. We will add crews to events where it will not increase the number of races for that event.
2. We will add crews to events currently with 7 entries up to a maximum of 12.
3. We will then review the number of races we have spare (up to a maximum of 135/day).

These movements will be made in the next few days and your Club Entry Administrator will receive a notification via BROE2.

We will continue to look at options to accommodate further crews.

British Rowing is sincerely grateful to the Organising Committee, which is largely volunteers, for their time in trying to accommodate these entries. Please read the below carefully and refer to the Notice of Competition before emailing a query.

Q&A

Why is there a maximum number of races per day?

The number of races is limited to keep the racing day manageable for all involved including travelling competitors and volunteers.

When will the timetable/list of entries be published?

As per the original Notice of Competition, the Draw will take place on Sunday 7 June 2026 and will be posted on the British Rowing website by 19:00 on Monday 8 June 2026.

Racing will start at 09:00 each day and finish no later than 19:00.

Can I still enter?

Yes, but you will go onto the waiting list. We will accept additional entries as per the above strategy or where a scratch is made before the close of entries (13:00 on 1 June 2026).

If I withdraw, will I receive a refund?

Yes, up until the formal close of entries (13:00 on 1 June 2026). After that, no refunds will be made.

My crew is still on the waiting list. When will I know if I have made it into the draw?

Using the above strategy, we will continue to look at options to accommodate further crews up until the formal close of entries. Please do not email us for an update as we will not be able to give a timeframe.

If my entry does not make it from the waiting list to the main Draw, will the entry fee be refunded?

Yes, this will be done when the draw is completed, at which point no further entries will be accepted.
